The OCCA Cheerleader Academic All State recognizes the scholastic achievements of graduating seniors. Only current cheerleading coaches that are presently members of the Oklahoma Cheerleading Coaches Association and the Oklahoma Coaches Association will be able to nominate candidates for this award. The program is independently managed by OCCA.

ELIGIBILITY

All graduating senior cheerleaders who meet **ALL** of the following criteria are eligible to receive the honor of "Cheerleading Academic All State"

1. Minimum ACT score of 25 or SAT score of 1140
2. Cumulative GPA of 3,75 or above on a 4.0 scale (based on the first 7 semesters)
3. Three years of cheering school cheerleading experience is a minimum
4. Nominating coach must be a current member of OCCA

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

All nomination forms, along with an up-to-date official transcript should be mailed to OCCA Secretary. All information must be submitted together and must be postmarked by March 1, 2022. The coaches will be notified of their Academic All State winners. A certificate will also be mailed to the coach. The recipient will receive their plaque during the OCCA Honors Ceremony at coaches clinic held the last week of July.
